Our children surprised us again with their hard work at school. They really grab the opportunity they were given and they do it literally with both hands.

In 2017 we closely cooperated with the Ugandan government and the police authorities in investigating the background of every child, in finding the family roots and relatives. And we are very happy that in many cases we found at least some family connections. Although children are still supervised by our organization, we can start connecting them, little by little, with their extended families, which is invaluable and essential step for their future.

As one of our major milestones in 2017 we need to highlight our MoU with KCCA and start of amazing partnership in effort to relieve the plight of orphans and street children in Kampala City. We have been also granted with a Certificate of approved home from the Ministry of Gender in Uganda for a duration of 5 years.

Both of these milestones are opening doors for us in many areas to give better future to more children - greater things are yet to come!

In addition, in Uganda we focused on running and improving our primary school, where the number of children grew again. With the growing number of children, of

course, our responsibility for the quality of education is growing, so in 2017 we invested in expanding the base of our professional pedagogical strength and, last but not least, we filled a key role of headmaster, driving us forward.

A big breakthrough occurred not only in Uganda, but also in our global organization. Our subsidiary Good Future and Hope Deutschland e.V. started working fully this year. It focuses primarily on fundraising activities and better support for the growing community of our German individual and corporate sponsors.

Thanks to generous contribution we also started with a the reconstruction of our original website, which has undergone an overall change. However, as part of the change, we did not just stay with the website. We have also changed the corporate identity of our foundation.

Of course, we could also see progress in Myanmar, where we were most pleased with the progress of children in their education. We have the first university graduate! This year, many activities were organized for the children, not only having fun, but also making new friends with children from the surrounding area.

Nothing of what happened in GFaH in 2017 could have happened without your support. We would like to thank you one more time for your generosity and trust in us as a team. For being by our side, even though we could sometimes do things more quickly, better and more professionally.

SUPPORT OF LOCAL DEVELOPMENT

We employ local people to work in the children homes, school and on the construction site. We aim to support the local communities, start self-sustaining projects and help children to become independent. In this way, we want to avoid the long-term dependence on the sponsors from abroad.

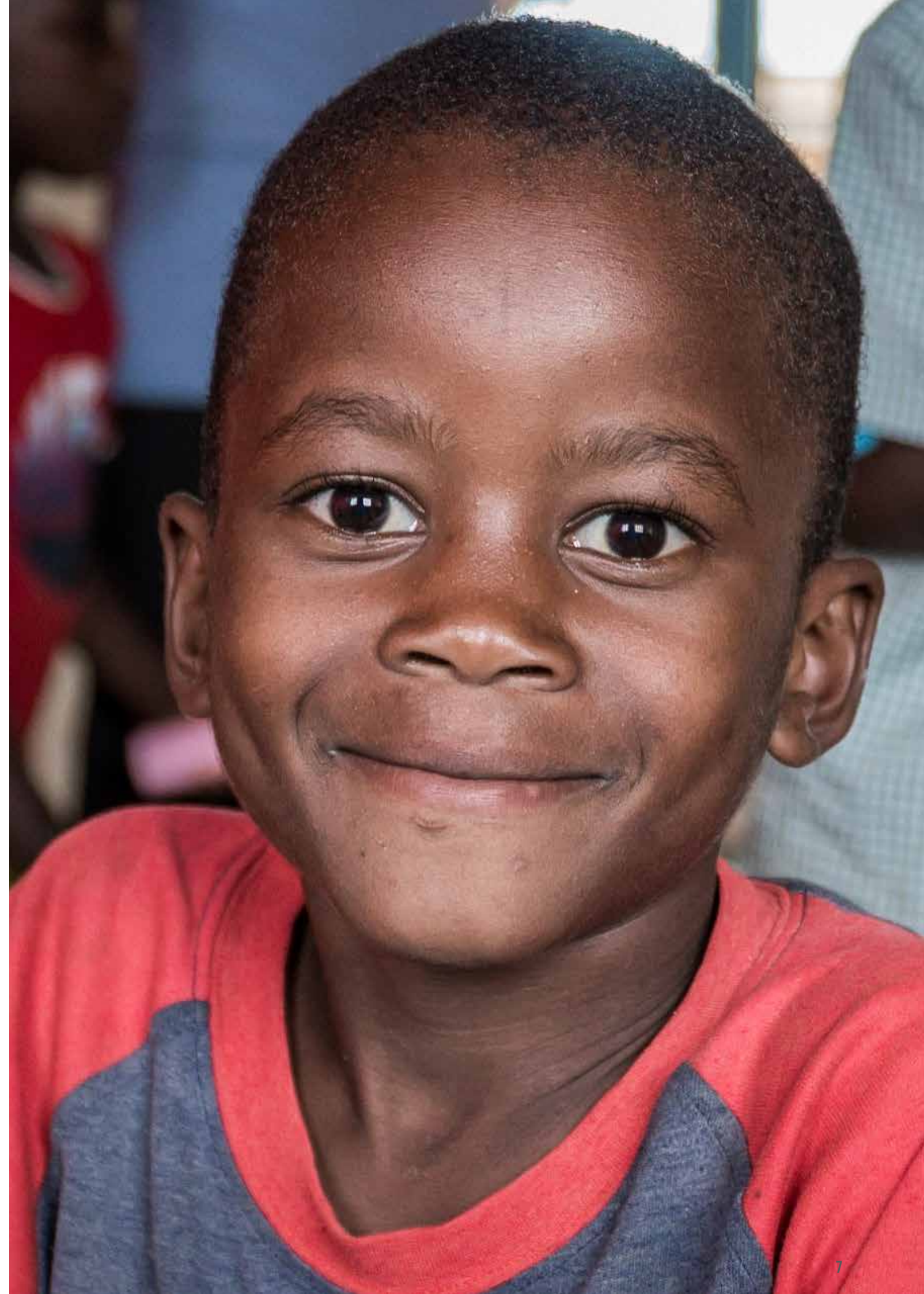

GENERAL OVERVIEW OF THE GLOBAL ORGANIZATION

- In February 2017, we managed to establish the German branch - Good Future and Hope Deutschland eV, which focuses primarily on fundraising activities and better support for the growing community of our German individual and corporate sponsors.
- As part of the activities of Good Future and Hope Deutschland e.V in 2017, we applied for a grant from several German companies.
- In November 2017, thanks to a generous sponsorship contribution, we started with the reconstruction of our original website, which has undergone a complete change. As a result, we did not only change the website. We also changed the corporate identity of our organization. We rejuvenated not only our look, but we also ensured a simpler navigation.
- As part of improving communication, we have hired a new volunteer who communicates with virtual adoption sponsors.
- In collaboration with the German movie director Burkhard Feige and his team, we have received as a gift a documentary movie about our organization. Movie was officially presented to the public at the end of 2017 in the German version, where famous narrator Franz Robert Wagner and actress Nina Friederike Gnädig gave us their voice.

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2 PRIMARY SCHOOL
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CHILDREN'S HOME

- As GFaH Ministries we currently support 65 children – in different programs. 34 of them are currently living in children’s home (incl. children of foster mothers), 37 of them are supported through our educational program.
- During the year we closely cooperated with the Ugandan government and the police authorities in investigating the background of every child in our care, in finding the family roots and close or distant relatives. In year 2016 we resettled 13 children and in 2017 we resettled another 19 children. All of them are still supported by GFaH in our educational program.
- We were granted a Certificate of approved home from the Ministry of Gender in Uganda for a duration of 5 years
- In year 2017, one of the main milestones was signed Memorandum of Understanding with KCCA and start of amazing partnership in effort to relieve the plight of orphans and street children in Kampala City
- As result of cooperation with KCCA, we have already received 7 new children from Naguru rehabilitation center and we have also admitted one new child with cooperation of police and the probation officer from neighborhood community.
- As every year, 2017 was not exception for our GFaH Summer children’s camp, with participation of all children we support, plus children from neighboring community
- To not forget about awareness and knowledge on some importance topics, we had very successful four phase workshop on – Children rights, advocacy and protection; HIV prevention and stigma management; Cultural awareness; Code of conduct, public etiquettes and principle of professional behavior
- 4 of our children successfully finished primary level school and have been promoted to secondary school
- 3 of our children joined secondary school where they benefit not only from educational program but as well from vocational program to get useful skills for their future.
- 2 children successfully finished S4
- In spring 2017 we built a new playground which serves as recreational area for all our children
- We also started the construction of wall around our premises – phase 1 finished.
- We have successfully audited our accounts for whole ministry, by certified auditing company
- As part of our self sustainability efforts we planted and harvested 550kg of beans and plantation of Matoke (400 pcs), for own use to improve nutrition of children and save cost on food.



PRIMARY SCHOOL

- The total school enrollment in 2017 comprised of 179 pupils, with 69 pupils in nursery and 110 pupils in the primary section. (53 children boarding / 126 children daily)
- We have filled crucial position of Headmaster and recruited three more teachers, two for primary and one for nursery section. Total school staff as of December 2017 was 24: 1 Headmaster, 13 teachers, 4 matrons, 3 cooks, 2 cleaners and 1 driver. We work with an external security firm to ensure 24/7 security on the compound.
- We have successfully completed of syllabus in all classes.
- Promotion of pupils in all classes by 98%.
- As improvement in our school operation, we have opened bank account for majority of our employees and managed to start payments of staff salaries through the bank.
- We purchased more furniture for both nursery and primary school.
- Provision of free holiday work package to all learners.
- We participated in national registration and all the primary pupils have been registered for the National identity cards.
- As enrichment of our curriculum, we started we co-curriculum activities and Introduction of clubs and societies in the school. We have now home economics club; music, dance & drama club, red cross club, scouts club, games & sports club, debating club, scripture union club.
- We have organized very successful study tour for both nursery and primary children organized by a travel agency, where we explored wo different places,
- In 2017 we have been providing transport to daily children from over 20 villages in neighborhood community
- As part of education of our teaching forces, we have provided on-site computer training for all teachers (phase 1 – computer basics, Microsoft office basics)
- We provided very successful four phase workshop on – Children rights, advocacy and protection; HIV prevention and stigma management; Cultural awareness; Code of conduct, public etiquettes and principle of professional behavior
- All children and staff received free HIV checkup with consultations.





MYANMAR

- In Myanmar, in 2017, our first graduate. Bawi Pa graduated from a higher education degree with a focus on electrical engineering and computer science.
- Two of the children completed high school and started a practical training to provide them with useful experience and knowledge.
- Our local partners, Run and Grace, organized a sports day for kids from our children's center and the surrounding villages, full of fun and various competitions. The children showed their competitiveness and fought with full engagement until the end.
- During the year we also organized a day full of fun at our children's center, where several teams competed to build a sand town and a flower garden.
- During the holidays, Grace spent great time with children teaching them to cook various local delicacies, which benefited not only their skills but also their gourmet taste buds.

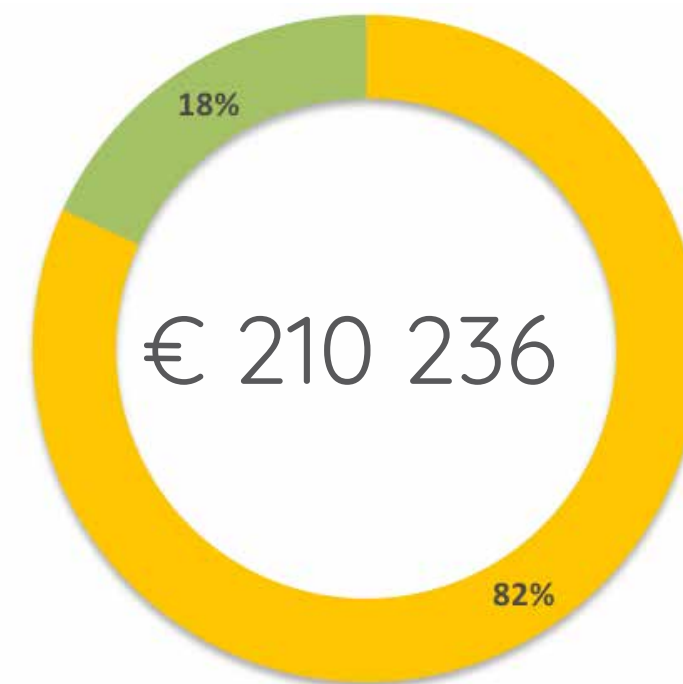

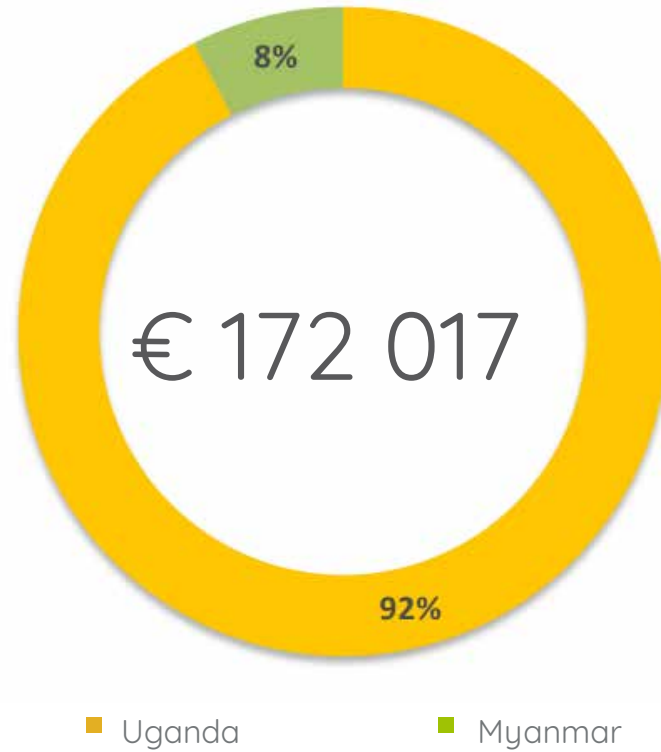

OUR PLANS FOR THE YEAR 2018

UGANDA

- Completion of the first circle of 9 houses will help us save roughly 30 more children. The completion of the construction of 4 more houses from the foundations up to the roof / required budget: 4 x 25.000 EUR = 100.000 EUR / **Completion planned for January 2018**
- Extension of the primary school complex / required budget: 60.000 EUR for the construction of the class- rooms for grades P5-P7, 77.000 EUR for the fully equipped school kitchen and dining room, 112.000 EUR for two dormitory buildings/
- Drain system for school and children's home / required budget: 5.000 EUR /
- Rain water collection project / required budget: 10.000 EUR /
- Purchase of used 4x4 vehicle / required budget: 5.000 EUR /

MYANMAR

- Planned trip in second quarter 2018 with goal to plan strategy with our local partner.
- Give the children in our program the best possible chance of passing the final exams successfully in the 11th grade through the paid tutoring in the afternoon sessions
- Extension of the sponsorship program by adding contributions that will ensure that older children after the completion of 11th grade will get a vocational training with a specific focus, which will pave the way for them to become self-employed or financially independent.

ADMINISTRATION OF THE FOUNDATION

- Operation expenses of the organization / 10.000 EUR /
- Salaries and taxes for two employees / 15.000 EUR /
- Travel expenses for two employees / 6.500 EUR /
